

Adaptive Sports Iowa Split the Pot Raffle Volunteer COVD-19 Protocols & Guidelines

Due to COVID-19, below are protocols and guidelines to be followed for all Iowa Wild homes games in 2021. It is expected that all volunteers follow these guidelines in order to stay safe. We appreciate your cooperation!

- Please continue to social distance by staying at least 6 feet apart when possible.
- Volunteers are asked to wear a mask at all times.
- We ask that you please take your temperature before arriving for your shift. If you have a temperature higher than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, we ask that you stay home.
- Volunteers are asked to not linger around after their shift. Once you are relieved from your shift you may stay for the rest of the game or leave Wells Fargo Arena.
- Prior to coming to the event, please review the following pre-screening questions. If the answer is "yes" to any of these questions, volunteers are asked to stay home.
 - Have you or anyone in your household had any of the following symptoms in the last 14 days: sore throat, chills, body aches for unknown reasons, shortness of breath for unknown reasons, loss of smell, loss of taste, fever at or greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit?
 - Have you been in contact with anyone that has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 2 weeks?
 - Have you or anyone in your household tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 2 weeks?
 - Are you or anyone in your household waiting for COVID-19 test results?
 - Do you have any reason to believe you or anyone in your household has been exposed to anyone with COVID-19 or anyone exhibiting the symptoms in the last 2 weeks?
